him more tense and fearful. He grips very tightly when he's being moved; it's alarming to him. Although he's now nonverbal, there are some things he still understands and his caretakers attempt to reach him. I feel good about that."

With health care in a senior community, it is often the little things that are so comforting to both the patient and the family. At Pine Run, it's well understood that every patient's needs are unique and important, no matter how small or large they may seem. Clara says her requests for anything she may be concerned about for Lee are "always received respectfully and acted upon, if possible."

When his eyeglasses break, as they frequently do because he bends them, the staff has a reliable vendor who can quickly repair them. When Lee is upset or frightened, the aides give him something to hold onto.

"They think ahead for him anticipating how he will react and how they can help him," Clara says. "They make every effort to understand and involve him. That's a great comfort to me."

"We have proximity to family here, and the connection to Doylestown Hospital gave us the impetus to make this our choice. In fact, we were able to continue seeing our same doctors."

Working within the Doylestown Health System allows Pine Run Health Center's health care providers to coordinate care and treatment plans with the hospital and the health system's network of doctors and other providers.

Short-Term Rehab Care Earns Top Rating

In addition to long-term nursing care and memory care, Pine Run Health Center offers short-term rehabilitation services for older adults who may need some support getting back on their feet. Seniors who are mending from surgery such as joint replacement or recovering from a stroke or other illness can rely on Pine Run Health Center whether they need care for just a few days or up to several weeks.

Pine Run Health Center offers on-site licensed physical, occupational, and speech therapies under the direction of a physician specializing in rehabilitative medicine. Every member of the team is committed to helping older adults recover from hospital stays to build strength, maximize abilities, and regain independence.

Those rehab services have meant a great deal to Rick Lentine and his wife, Lois, who lives with dementia and Parkinson's disease. Lois has received care at Pine Run Health Center three times, after a number of falls, according to Rick. The Lentines found the high quality of care and concern demonstrated by the center's staff to be a lifesaver.

"We're very pleased with the care offered at Pine Run Health Center," Rick says. "The staff and providers always follow up to see how we're doing, which means a lot."

The Lentines also value the prompt and efficient communication between themselves, the nursing staff, and the doctors. "If you need to ask a doctor a question, the staff will convey the message and get back to you," Rick says. "They'll explain the information clearly, and I appreciate that."
