place each implant under the direction of a seasoned clinician, according to Dr. Dudhat.

"The technology begins with a patient's 3D X-rays so we know exactly where to place the implant," he says. "I will then direct the robotic arm to place the implant in the precise spot, and at the proper depth, each time. This is brand-new technology, and we're happy to use it if it leads to the patient having the best possible result."

Technology isn't the only area in which D3 Dental is investing in its future. The practice recently added a third clinician: Viviana Portillo, D.M.D.

After graduating from the University of Pennsylvania School of Dental Medicine, Dr. Portillo completed her dental residency at Englewood Hospital in Englewood, New Jersey, just across the Hudson River from her hometown of New York City. She brings to the practice a wealth of experience, youthful energy, and an interest in cosmetic dentistry and dental surgery. In fact, she supplemented her training by completing a 300-hour continuing-education course focused on dental implants.


