A unique methodology known as "reflexing," in which Sanford hand-separates the petals on each bloom, enables her to unlock the beauty of each rose.

'Reflexing opens the roses up to a size and dimension that's greater than what you would typically find," she says. "It's a self-taught way to really transform the flower, one that came from learning and getting to know roses as well as I have.

The same individualism applies to the way she approaches a client's event. In her eyes, each job provides an opportunity to meld the client's vision with her own expertise and style, making for grand results designed to leave guests in awe.

"I've always had a tendency to stand out that started when I was growing up," Sanford says. "Even now, I don't like to be cookiecutter. I really think outside the box. ... I don't like to be the same as other designers, or other
