sylvania, New Jersey, Delaware, southern New York, and Maryland. With major showrooms in King of Prussia, Philadelphia, Harrisburg, and Wilmington, Colonial Marble & Granite now delivers projects throughout the broader Northeast corridor.

The Foundation: Selection, Value, Precision
From the beginning, Colonial Marble & Granite believed that materials should be experienced, not just selected from a small sample.

Price transparency has been just as central.

Through direct sourcing and operational efficiency, Colonial Marble & Granite has consistently delivered premium materials at competitive prices. The goal has never been to compete only at the high end. It has been to make exceptional materials accessible to more homeowners.

Execution is where that promise becomes real. Colonial Marble & Granite operates advanced fabrication facilities using digital templating and precision CNC technology to ensure accuracy and consistency.
